Aim:

- The application form collects vital applicant details like education, nationality, religion, community status, parental occupation and income.
- The Principal, in consultation with the Secretary, appoints members to the Admission Committee, ensuring representation from senior faculty members and staff from reserved categories.
- An admission counseling office assists applicants, especially those from marginalized backgrounds, in selecting suitable courses based on their academic marks.
- The admission committee informs economically disadvantaged and marginalized students about management scholarships available at the time of admission, with recommendations made by the Principal.
