Statutory Declaration on RTI ACT

St. Joseph's College for Women, Tirupur, hereby declares that it exercises the right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities. This is aimed at promoting transparency and accountability in the workings of every public authority. This declaration is made in accordance with Section 4(I) (b) of the RTI Act 2005, as issued and amended from time to time. Additionally, it acknowledges the constitution of a Central Information Commission and State Information Commission, along with matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

THE RTI ACT

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005), enacted by Parliament and enforced from June 15, 2005, empowers citizens to access information held by public authorities, fostering transparency and accountability in their operations. All Universities and Colleges, whether established by Parliament, State Legislature, or through government notification, or substantially funded by government funds, fall under the ambit of a Public Authority as per this Act.

While certain provisions took immediate effect upon enactment, others would be enforced within 100/120 days. Universities and colleges are strongly advised to meticulously study the Act and undertake necessary measures for compliance, including proactive disclosure of pertinent information. This information should be readily accessible to the public via the respective institution's website, thereby ensuring transparency and accountability.
